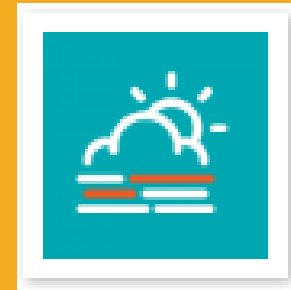

Each themes has a **dedicated Partnership**.

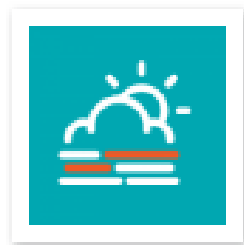
